October is Pet Oral Health Month

October is Pet Oral Health Month at Lake Country Veterinary Care. We are offering a 10% discount off our regular dental cleaning **ALL** month.

Research shows around the age of 2 years old, 70% of cats and 80% of dogs have some signs of dental disease. If left unchecked, periodontal disease and tooth loss may leave your pet prone to infections and that may affect other organs. Regular dental checkups and cleaning will help to promote the overall health of your pet.

Our professional staff can provide ultrasonic cleaning to remove the buildup of tartar and plaque. After cleaning, the teeth are polished smooth which provides a surface less likely to accumulate plaque. Finally, teeth and gingival surfaces are flushed with a special antiseptic rinse.

We also include a home maintenance packet and can instruct you on how to continue routine care at home.

All dental prophylaxis is done under anesthesia and requires your pet to stay in the hospital 4-6 hours. There are limited spots available so make your appointment now.

Make a copy of this email and bring it to your appointment for the 10% discount.

Please don't wait until the last minute to make your appointment because the surgery schedule fills up fast. Dental month only runs from Oct. 1st through Oct. 31th.
